Dear IMC friend in the faith of Jesus,

I am writing to you with important information for your church conference in relation to the IMC Congress in session 13-18 November 2023, in Port Harcourt, Nigeria. The Congress theme is "Equipped for the Global Mission."

All delegates, observers and translators who intend to participate in the Congress are to submit their registration forms, passport details, and a recent passport-sized photo (head and shoulders) to [imc-secretary@cog7.org](mailto:imc-secretary@cog7.org) by July 1. Registration forms are available for download at <https://imc.cog7.org/congress.html>. Other quick facts that will assist you in your planning, including a brief draft of the Congress agenda, are available at the same link.

Visas are available upon entry to Nigeria for all delegates. The church in Nigeria will prepare the visas in advance and have them ready for international delegates and observers upon arrival. Individual passports must be valid six months after the date of arrival in Nigeria. Yellow fever vaccination is mandatory for entry to Nigeria. Attendees should bring a current yellow fever vaccination card/document with their passport.

The registration fee is \$900 USD per person. This fee will cover local transportation, food, accommodation, security, and all other expenses required for each delegate during their time in Nigeria. Registration fees shall be paid online by September 1. Payment information is available online at <https://imc.cog7.org/donate.html>

Observers may attend the Congress but are not entitled to vote or deliberate. All observers must obtain written approval from their national conference president and submit to the IMC Secretary for approval by the IMC Officers.

The venue for Congress meetings and accommodations is located at Desikok Royal Hotel, 5-7 Abua Street, Port Harcourt, Rivers State, Nigeria. International attendees should purchase direct flights to Port Harcourt from international destinations if possible (Lufthansa, Air France, etc.). If transit is required within Nigeria, delegates should purchase airline tickets to Abuja and purchase separate airline tickets from Abuja to Port Harcourt. Customs officials and church members will be present to assist you in Abuja and Port Harcourt.

Delegates should review and be familiar with the IMC Bylaws in preparation for the Congress.

Join us in prayer, now in the remaining months until we assemble in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ and by means and counsel of the Holy Spirit, for the blessing and success of this Congress in session. Pray for all who will be traveling, for the safety, security and providence of all involved, now in the early stages of implementation and right on through each day of the Congress.

As of writing this, there are now 187 days remaining until we meet in Nigeria!
